## Financial Definitions

### Member Organization Fees

<b>Badge Fee:</b>	Each member organization has a badge/pin. Members are required to purchase a badge (not included in the initiation fee). Badges may be very simple or jeweled. If a member would like an “upgraded” badge, she will be charged more than the standard badge price provided above. One-time fee.

### Chapter Fees

<b>Chapter Dues:</b>	These dues fund member activities including programming, recruitment, chapter supplies and chapter operations.
<b>Sisterhood Events:</b>	Included in chapter dues. A minimum of 3 sisterhood events are planned each quarter. Examples include: ice skating, cycling class, build-a-bear, charcuterie boards, etc.
<b>Philanthropy Events:</b>	Included in chapter dues. Events for the year include (but not limited to): silent auction, pancake feed, “DZ Heart Attacks” (valentine’s), and “DZ Duke Out” (flag football tournament).
<b>Social/Special Events:</b>	Included in chapter dues. Events include (but not limited to): grab-a-date & formal each quarter.
<b>Initiation/New Member Fee:</b>	Fee paid to finalize initial membership in the organization. One-time fee.
<b>Panhellenic dues:</b>	These funds are used to support Panhellenic operations. Examples of items that may be included in the Panhellenic budget are educational programming (Hazing, Alcohol and Other Drugs, Interpersonal Violence, etc.), community philanthropy efforts, recruitment, and scholarships.

### Facility Fees

<b>Meal Plan:</b>	Meals include: lunch & dinner Monday-Thursday and brunch Friday. Full toast bar (cereal, yogurt, bread/bagels, snacks, etc.) is available at all times. Chapter dinner (Monday) is provided for all members that attend chapter (even if not on the meal plan). The meal plan is included in Room & Board for all in house members.
<b>Security Deposit:</b>	The security deposit is a one-time fee for all new members living in the house.
<b>House Corporation (NHC) Fees:</b>	National Housing Corporation (NHC) fees include parlor fees, building fund, furnishing fund, and administration fees.

### Notes (Optional)

- All statements are sent out monthly. Amounts provided above (that aren’t one time fees) are the monthly amount x3.
- If members are not able to pay monthly payments on time, payment plans can be created with the VP of Finance.
- Delta Zeta offers many scholarships each year that range from \$500 up to \$30,000.
- Room & Board is combined for those living in the house. Members not living in are given the option to opt out of the meal plan if requested.
