

## **Financial Definitions**

## **Member Organization Fees**

Headquarter Fees	Fee paid to inter/national organization per member to support overall sorority operations. We call these Per Capita Fees.		
	Chapter Fees		
Chapter dues:	These dues fund member activities including programming, recruitment, chapter supplies and chapter operations.		
Sisterhood Events:	Mariners Games, Food/dessert trucks, Movie/Game nights, Trampoline parks, Rollar skating, Holiday Parties (Galentines, Winter, etc). All incurred costs including transportation is included in chapter dues.		
Philanthropy Events:	Kappa Auction, Grilled Cheese Feed, KyliePalooza (a fashion festival), Kristi's Kickball, etc. All incurred costs including transportation is included in chapter dues.		
Social/Special Events:	Formals, Grab-A-Dates (GAD), every 4 years is a big formal called IceHouse, Formal Dinners, Scholarship Dinners, etc. All incurred costs including transportation is included in chapter dues.		
New member fee:	Fee paid to establish membership in the organization.		
Panhellenic dues:	These funds are used to support Panhellenic operations. Examples of items that may be included in the Panhellenic budget are educational programming (Hazing, Alcohol and Other Drugs, Interpersonal Violence, etc.), community philanthropy efforts, recruitment, and scholarships.		
	Facility Fees		
Meal Plan:	Hot breakfast, lunch, and dinner Monday-Friday. Brunch on Saturday, dinner on Sunday. Snacks and small/easy made food ("toast bar") available 24/7. Available to all members living in and all members paying for the opt-in meal plan as live outs.		
Live Out Fee:	The entire membership has access to the house and thus the property is subject to a great deal of wear and tear. This fee is used primarily for care and maintenance of the property and furnishings in the common areas of the chapter facility. Non-meal plan live-outs have access to dinner on Mondays, lunch on Fridays, brunch on Saturdays, and 24/7 toast bar.		
Maintenance Fee	Covers routine maintenance of the facility and its contents. The fee must cover insurance premium costs.		
House Corporation Fee:	Paid in the following 2 quarters after initiation. Provides for lifetime membership in the house corporation. The fee is to be used to establish reserve funds for long-term capital improvements and future needs for the chapter (e.g., roof replacement, major renovations, sponsoring chapter leadership attendance at		



#### **Notes (Optional)**

- Any Kappa event is covered by dues thoroughly. Including ubers/transportation to venues, food, and activities. Members do not pay to be involved in any event planned by the organization.
- There are many scholarships available at all levels in Kappa to help members cover payments. These have yearly, quarterly, and rolling application cycles to assist members any time of year.
- We offer a payment plan for individuals who may need to split up payments, making it a monthly payment instead of quarterly.
- Kappa does NOT participate in any fining of members for anything. There are no fines for members who miss events, break rules, etc.
- Meal plans for live-outs are available and provide access to all meals provided by Kappa when you optin to the meal plan for \$300 a quarter. This meal plan is included in the cost of Room & Board when living in.
- A 3% credit card fee is added on all dues paid by card. Routing information and check do not incur these costs.
