Financial Definitions

Member Organization Fees

Badge Fee	Each member organization has a badge/pin. Some organizations require a member to purchase a badge and others include it in the initiation fee. Badges may be very simple or jeweled. If a member is purchasing her badge, she determines how much or little she would like to spend.
National Dues	Fee paid to inter/national organization per member to support overall sorority operations.
National New Member Fees	Fee paid to national organization one time, during the first quarter of membership, to provide sisterhood packets, bond cards, and pay the certificate fee.

Chapter Fees

Chapter dues:	These dues fund member activities including programming, recruitment, chapter supplies and chapter operations.
Sisterhood Events:	There is no additional fee for sisterhood events. Alpha Chi Omega usually hosts 2-3 sisterhood events/bondings per month, which has included permanent jewelry, bracelet making, and Dave & Busters in the past.
Philanthropy Events:	There is no additional fee for philanthropy events. However, there are multiple opportunities to donate to our partnership with a Domestic Violence Awareness Organization during our philanthropy week.
Social/Special Events:	Social events, such as formals, usually do not have an additional fee. However, depending on the venue and scale of the event, tickets may have to be purchased by members individually.
Panhellenic dues:	These funds are used to support Panhellenic operations. Examples of items that may be included in the Panhellenic budget are educational programming (Hazing, Alcohol and Other Drugs, Interpersonal Violence, etc.), community philanthropy efforts, recruitment, and scholarships.
T-shirt Fee	This fee goes towards providing free apparel for members every quarter.

Facility Fees

Meal Plan:	We provide lunch and dinner Monday through Thursday, just lunch on Friday, and just dinner on Sunday. In addition, we also have a fully stocked toast bar and several appliances that are available to everyone.
Dues to Support Facility Operations:	The entire membership has access to the house and thus the property is subject to a great deal of wear and tear. This fee is used primarily for care and maintenance of the property and furnishings in the common areas of the chapter facility.

Notes

- The Badge fee for new members is subject to change, our national organization provides several different badge options that initiates are able to choose from, and then they are billed accordingly.
- Panhellenic dues are covered by the chapter's budget
