Financial Definitions

Member Organization Fees

Badge Fee	Each member organization has a badge/pin. Some organizations require a member to purchase a badge and others include it in the initiation fee. Badges may be very simple or jeweled. If a member is purchasing her badge, she determines how much or little she would like to spend.
International Fee:	Fee paid to inter/national organization per member to support overall sorority operations.

Chapter Fees

Chapter dues:	These dues fund member activities including programming, recruitment, chapter supplies and chapter operations.			
Sisterhood Events:	Sisterhood events include thinks like cookie decorating around the holidays, coffee stand during finals week, and Monday movie nights.			
Philanthropy Events:	Red Dress Gala: \$200 annually. Our largest philanthropy event of the year where we throw an auction and raise money for women's heart health. Last year we raised over \$119K at this singular event.			
Social/Special Events:	This fee includes things like formal events thrown each quarter. For example fall, winter and spring formals. This also includes other more casual events like a bowling night.			
Initiation fee:	Initiation Fee: \$172. Fee paid to finalize initial membership in the organization.			
New member fee:	New Member Fee: \$58. Fee paid to establish membership in the organization.			
Panhellenic dues:	Panhellenic Dues: \$110 (annually) These funds are used to support Panhellenic operations. Examples of items that may be included in the Panhellenic budget are educational programming (Hazing, Alcohol and Other Drugs, Interpersonal Violence, etc.), community philanthropy efforts, recruitment, and scholarships.			
Security Deposit:	Collected for security of the house and specifically for the current room the new member will be occupying. Room deposit is \$300.			
House Bond:	Money Is used for major improvements to the chapter facility. House bond is \$450.			
Bill Highway:	Bill highway is the system we use to collect dues. There is a processing fee if paying with credit card that is refundable if dues have been paid with cash.			
Founder's Day Pennies:	This charge is here to help fund leadership training programs for Alpha Phi officers.			
House Key:	This is the issuance of the house key so members have access to the house.			
Recruitment Room and Board:	This pays for room and board and the meal plan during the weeks of recruitment before school begins.
