Badge Fee	\$100 minimum, one-time payment Fall Quarter for your Gamma Phi Beta pin		
Inter/national Fee:	Included in Chapter Dues  • This fee is paid by all collegiate members to Gamma Phi Beta International Headquarters. This fee covers the annual programming costs and administrative functions to operate an international organization and is billed only to initiated members.		

## **Chapter Fees**

Chapter dues:	<ul> <li>Uniform quarterly fee among all members (live-In and live-out members)</li> <li>This quarterly fee covers costs for the quarterly fees paid to Gamma Phi Beta International Headquarters. The remaining chapter dues cover the cost of the chapter operations, social events, sisterhoods, senior celebration, philanthropy events, leadership development, and Panhellenic dues.</li> </ul>			
Sisterhood Events:	Covered by Chapter Dues, fee to cover expenses of fun events and activities planned and held among the chapter to engage members and inspire sisterhood (ie. Halloween pumpkin decorating, movie nights, picnics, exchanges with other chapters of Panhellenic, etc.)			
Philanthropy Events:	Covered by Chapter Dues, costs of the events held to raise money for our philanthropy - Girls on the Run (events such as Moonball and annual auction)			
Social/Special Events:	Covered by Chapter Dues, events planned by the chapter at external locations to bring members, their families, and the community closer (ie. Father Daughter Dance, Mother Daughter Brunch, Homecoming weekend events, quarterly social events like formals or grab-a-date's)			
New member fee/ House Corporation Fee:	<ul> <li>Fee paid the first three quarters living in the house. After three payments the fee stops</li> <li>This first-year fee provides resources to the HCB for present and future repairs and maintenance costs not covered in the operating budget and other costs to maintain or furnish communal spaces for the chapter house and annex.</li> </ul>			
Panhellenic dues:	These funds are used to support Panhellenic operations. Examples of items that may be included in the Panhellenic budget are educational programming (Hazing, Alcohol and Other Drugs, Interpersonal Violence, etc.), community philanthropy efforts, recruitment, and scholarships
